### **St. Michael's Necessity Pantry**

The next service opportunities for **The Necessity Pantry at St. Michael's** are 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 13<sup>th</sup>, and from 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon on Saturday, April 17<sup>th</sup>. Items needed for April include: toilet paper, disposable diapers (size 1), denture cleaner, dishwashing liquid, women's deodorant, Depends (size S/M), shampoo, disposable razors, denture cleaner, toothpaste, and feminine hygiene products. The Pantry can always use your extra grocery/shopping bags, which is a good way to “recycle” these. Also, please remember the Pantry when you are doing spring cleaning – clients can use your clean, gently worn spring and summer clothing.

### **Hillcrest Transitional Housing**

The **Hillcrest Walk for the Homeless** is coming up on Saturday, May 15<sup>th</sup>! Please sign up to be on the St. Anne's walk team. Details are on the entry desk in the narthex. 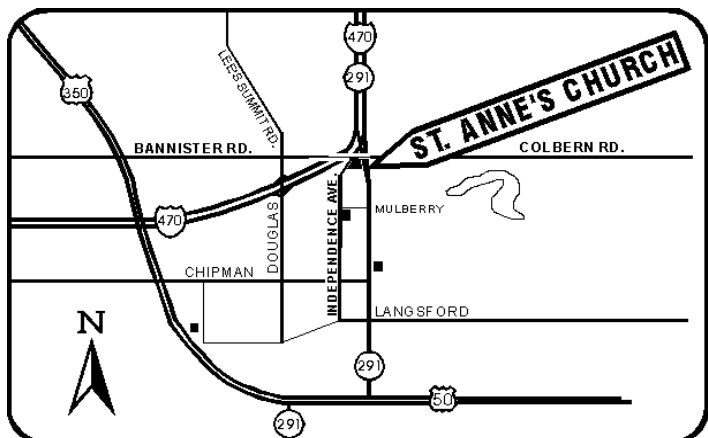
